Message from Director of Education

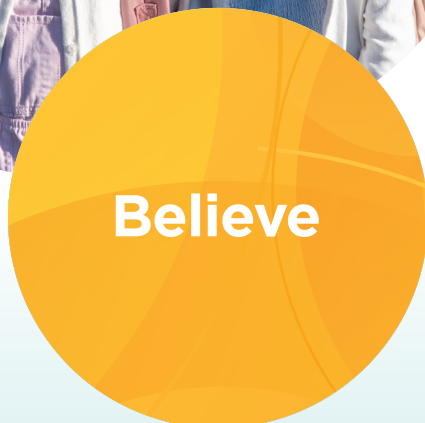

- Deepen the opportunities for staff to participate in adult faith formation.





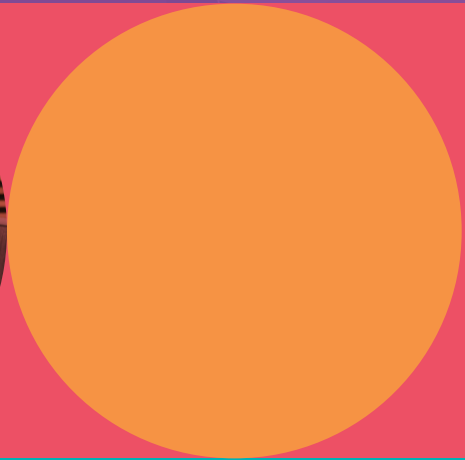

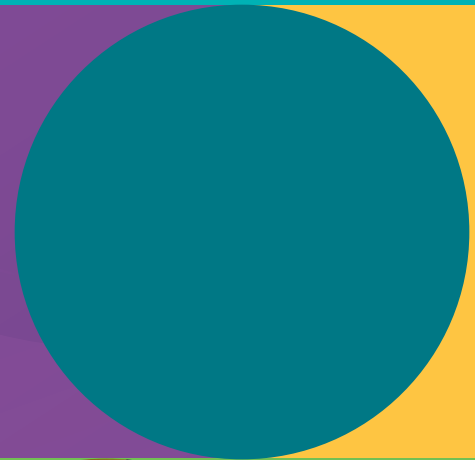
Strengthen our fidelity to Catholic social teachings and faith formation.

- Partner with our families of parishes and lay ministry groups (e.g. Catholic Women's League, Development and Peace, Knights of Columbus, St. Vincent de Paul Society) to support experiential learning that is rooted in Catholic social teachings.
- Provide professional learning on Catholic curricula, teaching strategies and resources to ensure that all courses and learning spaces have a clear focus on Catholic identity.
- Celebrate the joys of Catholic faith across the district with regular and meaningful communications with our homes and parishes.
- Nurture a culture of discernment with courageous conversations and honest feedback to establish that our pedagogical practices have fidelity to our faith, Catholic resources and curricula in all learning spaces.

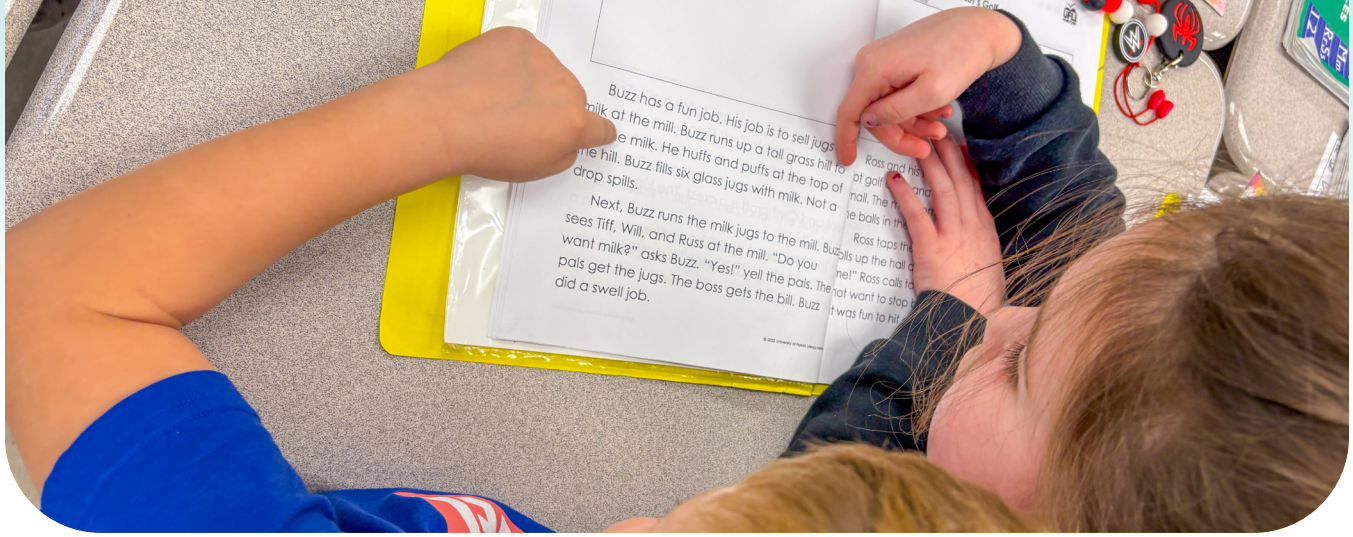
Commitment

Implement high standards for excellence in Catholic education.

Actions

- Continue the pathways of excellence with our Literacy Action Plan for systematic language development, early identification, screening and explicit reading interventions.
- Implement and monitor our Math Achievement Action Plan to verify the fidelity of implementation and the intentional use of proven teaching strategies in mathematics.
- Monitor and validate the effectiveness of our student achievement plans with purposeful assessment and evaluation data.
- Provide tiered interventions, culturally responsive pedagogy and evidence-based teaching practices for all students.
- Ensure that leadership practices are consistent across the district to provide feedback and effectively respond to instructional needs.
- Provide professional learning for staff that is directly aligned with high-impact strategies.

Increase student achievement with evidence-informed practices in special education and differentiated learning.

Actions

- Reinforce our commitments to evidence-informed practices and the alignment of services in special education.
- Host regular reviews of the impact of interventions for students with exceptionalities to differentiate and modify instructional strategies.
- Provide informed feedback across the district for the consistent use of Learning for All and effective practices in assessment and instruction in special education.
- Ensure that Individual Education Plans are implemented consistently in all learning spaces with fidelity to the recommendations of professionals.
- Provide support to schools rooted in the appropriate allocation of staffing and resources for differentiation, modifications and accommodations.
- Provide professional learning that fosters inclusion and students' access to a spectrum of programs and services in special education.

Actions

- Nurture inclusive learning spaces and work environments to embrace the teachings of Jesus Christ and the art of accompaniment, acceptance and love.
- Foster a culture of care and an ethic of respect so that everyone feels valued, welcomed and informed.
- Provide clear and open communications with families and staff to nurture excellence, inclusive practices and continuous improvement.
- Strengthen our partnerships with parents, caregivers and leaders in a holistic commitment to Indigenous education that affirms our connection to all of creation and the sacred dignity of each person.
- Optimize resources and data to affirm a fiscally responsible Catholic school system that is founded on equity, alignment, risk mitigation, modernization and long-term sustainability.

Provide pathways for success with transferable skills and experiential learning.

Actions

- Ensure that students have experiential learning opportunities that develop transferable skills: innovation, critical thinking, collaboration, global citizenship and digital literacy.
- Provide meaningful, inquiry-based experiences for students to apply careful discernment with the use of emerging technologies.
- Nurture students and staff to think critically and examine the responsible use of artificial intelligence.
- Broaden the opportunities for students to refine the fundamentals of practical life skills, resilience, how to study, financial literacy and real-world applications of academic subjects.
- Improve graduation rates with engagement, career-focused learning, community partnerships and targeted supports for student success.
- Enhance the opportunities for students to transition to secondary school, post-secondary pathways, apprenticeships and careers in the skilled trades.

Nurture mental health and well-being in schools and workplaces with comprehensive programs and tiered supports.

Actions

- Implement our Mental Health Promotion and Prevention Programming with targeted small group sessions, intensive supports and services to specific populations of students.
- Enhance the coordination of mental health supports across the system to ensure equity and inclusion.
- Monitor our Mental Health Strategy to establish the fidelity of implementation and the intentional use of evidence-informed practices for health and well-being.
- Affirm that strategic planning identifies resource gaps and aligns key mental health initiatives across the district.
- Support the well-being of staff with adult faith formation and mental health initiatives that nurture, celebrate diversity and build a culture of community.
- Provide meaningful professional development for a foundation in resilience, social-emotional learning, supportive practices and healthy relationships.
